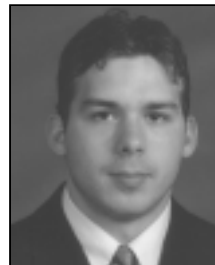

Athletic Nicknames

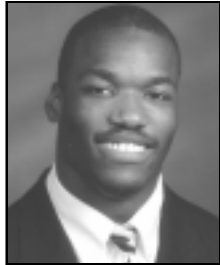
Wayne State University, by recommendation of a university-wide task force, adopted a new athletic identity system for the 2000-2001 academic year.

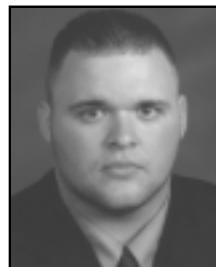

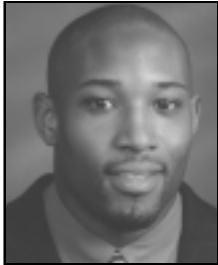

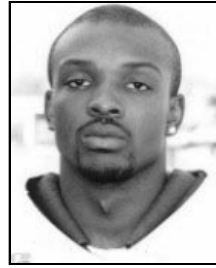
