Game Notes: UNI took control with 24 unanswered points in the first quarter after the Warriors took an early 7-0 lead ... on its second possession, WSU went 80 yards in 10 plays highlighted by Adam Nemer-Kaiser's 26-yard run on a fourth and eight ... UNI then scored on its next four possessions ... a 66-yard pass from Tom Petrie to Jake Soliday tied the game just 20 seconds after the Wayne State score ... following a WSU punt, UNI went 85 yards in 10 plays to take the lead for good ... a WSU fumble preceded a Panther field goal ... on the Warriors very next offensive play an interception set up a 57-yard touchdown drive for UNI ... early in the second quarter, WSU drove inside the 10, but an interception stopped the drive ... a missed field goal prevented any more WSU scoring in the first half ... the Warriors best chance to score in the third quarter was nullified when UNI blocked a 28-yard field goal attempt ... WSU's final score came when Nate Collins blocked a punt and returned it 40 yards for a touchdown.

Game Notes: In a see-saw game, Wayne State scored on the game's final play (a 33-yard field goal by Stephen Wayne) for the victory ... Ashland scored first, but the Warriors responded just 77 seconds later on a 62-yard pass from Jason Charron to Pierre Brown ... the Eagles regained the lead following an interception return to the 10-yard line ... WSU cut the deficit to one with a 15-play, 70-yard scoring drive which culminated in a 20-yard field goal by Stephen Wayne ... two Ashland field goals sandwiched around a Dan Gray to Pierre Brown nine-yard scoring toss had the game tied with 2:46 left in the fourth quarter ... after an exchange of punts, Wayne State drove from its 20-yardline for the winning score ... Gray completed four passes for 65 yards on the drive including a 14-yard toss to Pierre Brown on a third and 10 from Ashland's 29 ... Brown stepped out of bounds with three seconds left setting up Wayne's game-winning field goal ... also recording key receptions on the winning drive were Tim Steele (20 yards), Brown (18 yards) and Sterling Walker (13 yards).

Wayne State grabbed an early 7-0 lead after Marvin Beaty sacked FSU quarterback Tom Marsan on a fourth and four from WSU's 36 ... the Bulldogs tied the score on a three-play, 57-yard drive and proceeded to score 31 unanswered points ... FSU's next two scoring drives began in Warrior territory ... the Bulldogs scored first in the second half on a third and 11 pass play of 89 yards ... the Warriors second touchdown drive began after Ed Youngs recovered a fumble at FSU's 38 ... Pat Harwood capped off the scoring drive with his first collegiate touchdown on a one-yard run early in the fourth quarter ...
